What is the Difference between Qualitative and Quantitative Fit Testing?

Qualitative

- A pass/fail test based on the user's ability to taste an irritant, such as Bitrex or banana oil
- A person is fitted with a face mask, then a hood is placed over the head and the aerosol irritant is sprayed into the hood.
- Each test can take up to 20 mintes to complete.
- This method cannot provide testing for full-face respirators.



The wearer is asked to perform a number of breathing activities and short exercises to determine that the mask fits correctly on the face

Quantitative

- A person is fitted with a face mask, which is then connected to a machine called a PortaCount.
- The PortaCount measures the concentration of particles in the air as well as the concentration of particles respired into the face mask.
- The number of particles in the ambient air is then divided by the number of particles respired, this number is called the 'Fit Factor'.
- The quantative method is much faster and more accurate than the Qualitative method, and can effectively test the efficiency of full face masks.
- Each test takes less than 3 minutes
